FABRIC OF PLACE

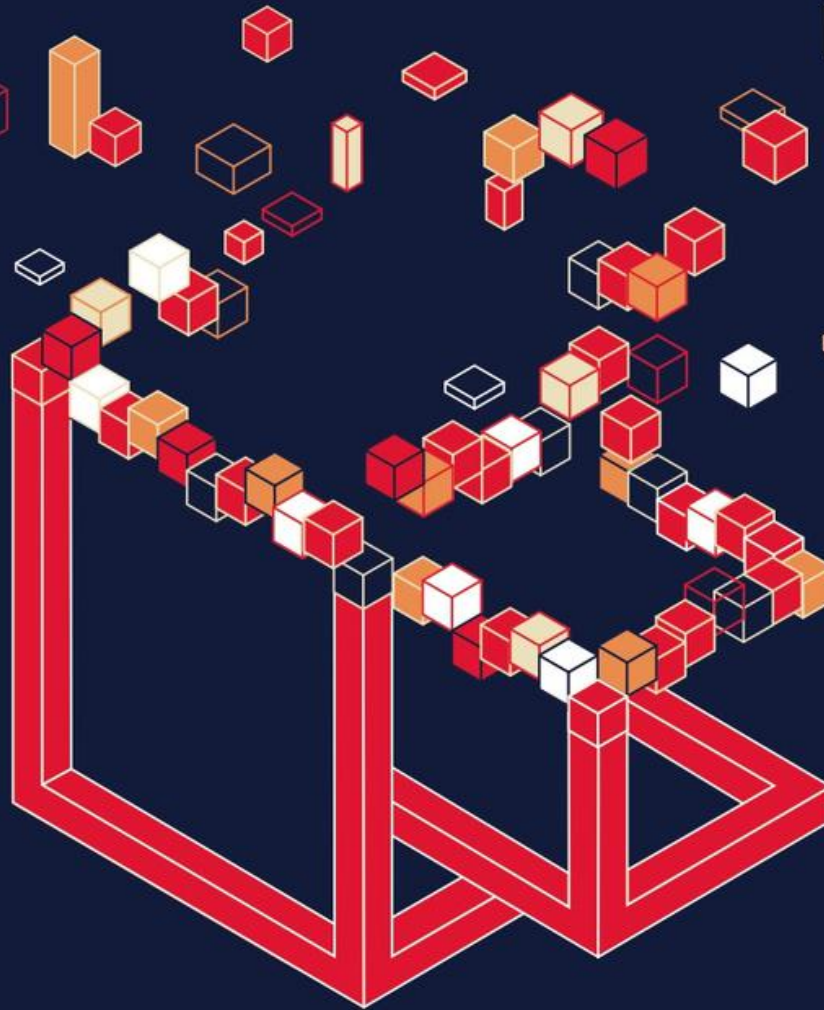
British architect Diane Haigh popularly known as Di died at the age of 73

Diane Haigh, who was widely known as Di, was a director at Allies and Morrison between 1996 and 2007 and a consultant director at the practice between 2011 and 2016. In 2007 she became director of design review at the Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment (CABE). Haigh was also a long-time teacher at the University of Cambridge, where she was director of studies at Trinity Hall between 1995 and 2016. At Allies and Morrison, Haigh led projects such as the refurbishment of the Royal Festival Hall (finished 2007) and Baillie Scott's Blackwell House in Cumbria (2001), as well as the refurbishment of Queen's House (1999) and the Astronomy Centre at the Royal Observatory (2007) in Greenwich. Haigh moved into a self-designed home in Cambridge in 1990 and continued to carry out work in the city until recently – such as a masterplan for St John's College (2017) and a new seminar pavilion for Darwin College (2019).
