




BELIEF IN BEAUTY

Luis Ramiro Barragan, the world-renowned Mexican architect, and the engineer found it alarming that publications devoted to architecture seemed to have banished the words, "Beauty, Inspiration, Magic, Spellbound, Enchantment, as well as the concepts of Serenity, Silence, Intimacy, and Amazement." He apologized for perhaps not having done these concepts complete justice, but said "they have never ceased to be my guiding lights." He spoke of the art of seeing. He felt that "It is essential to an architect to know how to see—to see in such a way that vision is not overpowered by rational analysis."
