Didi Contractor whose real name is Delia Kinzinger was a self - taught American architect known for her work on sustainable building in India using adobe, bamboo and stone for materials. She was born in 1929 in the USA to father, Edmund Kinzinger who was a German national and mother, Alice Fish Kinzinger who was an American. Both of them were renowned painters belonging to the Bauhaus group in the early 1920s. Didi Contractor grew up in Texas, USA, and spent some time in Europe also. They moved to Waco, Texas in 1935. She grew up in New Mexico and Texas, and took a year off from school to work in theatre. At the age of 11, she started to listen to Frank Lloyd Wright and saw an exhibition of his works along with her parents. This made a lasting impression on her mind and developed her inclination for the profession of architecture.
