



## **DIVIA AWARD 2025**

Vietnamese Architect Tran Thi Ngu Ngon Wins the 2025 Diversity in Architecture-DIVIA Award

The Diversity in Architecture (DIVIA) Award 2025 has been awarded to Vietnamese architect Tran Thị Ngụ Ngôn, founder of Tropical Space, in a ceremony held on 10 May 2025 at the European Cultural Centre, in Palazzo Mora in Venice. The award includes international recognition and a €10,000 prize, honouring women architects whose work contributes to cultural diversity and inclusion in architecture. This year's edition featured five other finalists: Carolina Rodas and Carla Chavez from Ecuador, Izaskun Chinchilla from Spain, Cazu Zegers from Chile, Patcharada Inplang from Thailand, and Surella Segu from Mexico, all of whom were presented as part of the Time Space Existence exhibition organized by the ECC.
