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

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Remembering Mahendra Raj, the man behind Delhi's iconic Pragati Maidan, described by New York Times as a 'brutalist masterpiece'

Structural engineer and designer Mahendra Raj, known for some of the most iconic buildings in the country, including the Hall of Nations in Pragati Maidan in Delhi and Salarjung Museum in Hyderabad, besides many other architectural marvels, passed away on 8 May, 2022 at the age of 97 in his home in Delhi, India. Born in Gujranwala in the Punjab state of the then undivided British India in 1924, he was born in a lower middle class family and was one of eight children. He completed his degree in civil engineering with honors from Punjab Engineering College in Lahore in 1946. After obtaining his degree, he joined the Punjab Public Works Department in their Buildings and Roads department. He moved to the Indian side after the partition of India in 1947 on one of the last trains to reach India safely. He collaborated with Corbusier on buildings including the Chandigarh High Court and the secretariat. He was noted to have proposed changes to the structure which resulted in a balanced cantilever resting on two columns.
