





MORBI BRIDGE COLLAPSE

The 'Jhulto Pul' or hanging bridge in Morbi collapsed on 30th October 22, our condolences to all families that lost their loved ones in this tragedy

At the latest count, 141 people have died after a pedestrian suspension bridge collapsed in Morbi, Gujarat on 30th October 2022. Rescue operations are underway and nine people have already been arrested. An FIR has been lodged against bridge maintenance and operation agencies. The Jhulto Pul ("hanging bridge") was a 230-metre (750 ft) long, 1.25-metre (4 ft 1 in) wide pedestrian suspension bridge over the Machchhu River, built during British rule in India in the 19th century. It was inaugurated on 20 February 1879 (143 years ago).
